**whole\_.\_** world, / **summoning** *all* the **faith\_ful** / to

**now** *with\_* joy, / we **chant** in *hymns* and  
**splen\_dor.** / Wherefore, O Plato, we **cry** to thee: //  
Deliver thy city from the invasion of the **heathen,** O  
**ho\_.\_.\_.\_.\_ly** one.
